# You're done reviewing the basics of Subject Verb Agreement!

Remember that:

- Singular subjects are paired with singular verbs, and plural subjects are paired with plural verbs.
- Prepositional phrases can make things seem tricky; it is good practice to pay no mind to any prepositional phrases that follow the subject.
- For sentences with linking verbs, the verb should always agree with the subject, and not the predicate nominative.
